Facts

- On May 26th 2009 The LAUSD Board of Education passed a motion requesting the City of Los Angeles and neighboring Cities to notify LAUSD of any planned cellular towers within 200 feet of our schools.
- On May 29th, 2009 a press release went out to all medias.
- On June 18th the Office of Environmental Health sent a letter to the City of Los Angeles
- On November 2nd, 2009 the Office of Environmental Health sent a follow up letter to the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power.
- Despite our early requests the responsible agency failed to notify the District, school and community
- On November 9th, 2009 Dr. Vladovic and LAUSD staff held a community meeting to discuss the cell tower placement and lack of notification.
- On December 8th at 1:00PM the LAUSD Board will vote on Dr. Vladovic's motion condemning T Mobile for their actions and demands all agencies to help us with this growing problem.
